## Dress Code Policy

### Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline The Japanese School of Melbourne (JSM)'s requirements for student dress and appearance.

### Scope

Students are expected to comply with this Dress Code Policy while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities.

### Policy

#### General appearance

Students must wear safe and student-appropriate clothing while at school, travelling to or from school or participating in school activities.

Student-appropriate clothing is clothing that is not overly revealing and covers the undergarment properly.

#### Jewellery and cosmetics

Students are not permitted to wear decorative jewellery, stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears. Watches are the only acceptable jewellery, however watches with functions other than watches, such as smart watches, are not permitted.

Cosmetics including nail polish may not be worn at school.

#### Hair and sun safety

Shoulder length or longer hair is to be tied back to help restrict the spread of head lice and for student safety.

Hats must be worn outside through the year and not to be worn inside.

Sunscreen must be applied and hats must be worn outside from the 1<sup>st</sup> of September to 30<sup>th</sup> of April.

Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities.
